Effective September 3, 2013, jobseekers entering the centers

will be required to follow the dress code guidelines listed below. Inappropriate attire will NOT be permitted. You will not be able to access services and will be asked to leave.

If you are in need of business casual or professional clothing, please speak with the center staff.
