CAREERSOURCE SOUTH FLORIDA ANNOUNCES READY TO WORK – EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

(MIAMI, May 8, 2014) – CareerSource South Florida announces the opening of registration for its Ready to Work – Employment Program, created to afford young adults the opportunity to enhance their work-readiness skills while earning an income. The program is aligned with the efforts of Actively Investing in Miami-Dade ("the AIM Initiative"), which was unveiled by Miami-Dade County Mayor Carlos A. Gimenez in 2013. The Mayor is calling upon local businesses to join him in a community-wide effort to expand job and internship opportunities for local young adults.

The program will provide local young adults with entry-level positions within governmental agencies/departments, local businesses, and community-based non-profit organizations. Program selection will be achieved through a lottery process for candidates who have met all program requirements.
