## SOUTH FLORIDA WORKFORCE TO UNVEIL WORKFORCE SERVICES PLAN

(MIAMI, September 23, 2011) — The South Florida Workforce Investment Board (SFWIB) will unveil its modified Local Workforce Services Plan. The SFWIB will host a series of community forums to afford the public an opportunity to comment on the plan.

The plan outlines SFWIB's business and job seeker programs and reflects organizational and strategic adjustments responsive to changes in the local economy. The plan is consistent with the State's 2011-2012 Workforce Investment Plan, emphasizing economic development strategies.

"South Florida's long-term economic viability will depend heavily on being able to compete successfully in the global economy. Thus, our local plan provides a blue print of services, programs and policies aimed at fostering job creation and business expansion," said Rick Beasley, executive director for the South Florida Workforce Investment Board.
